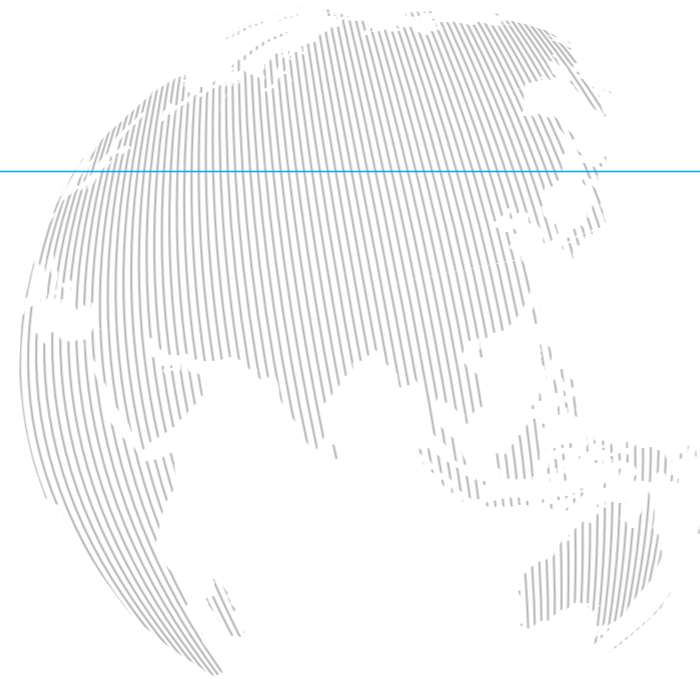

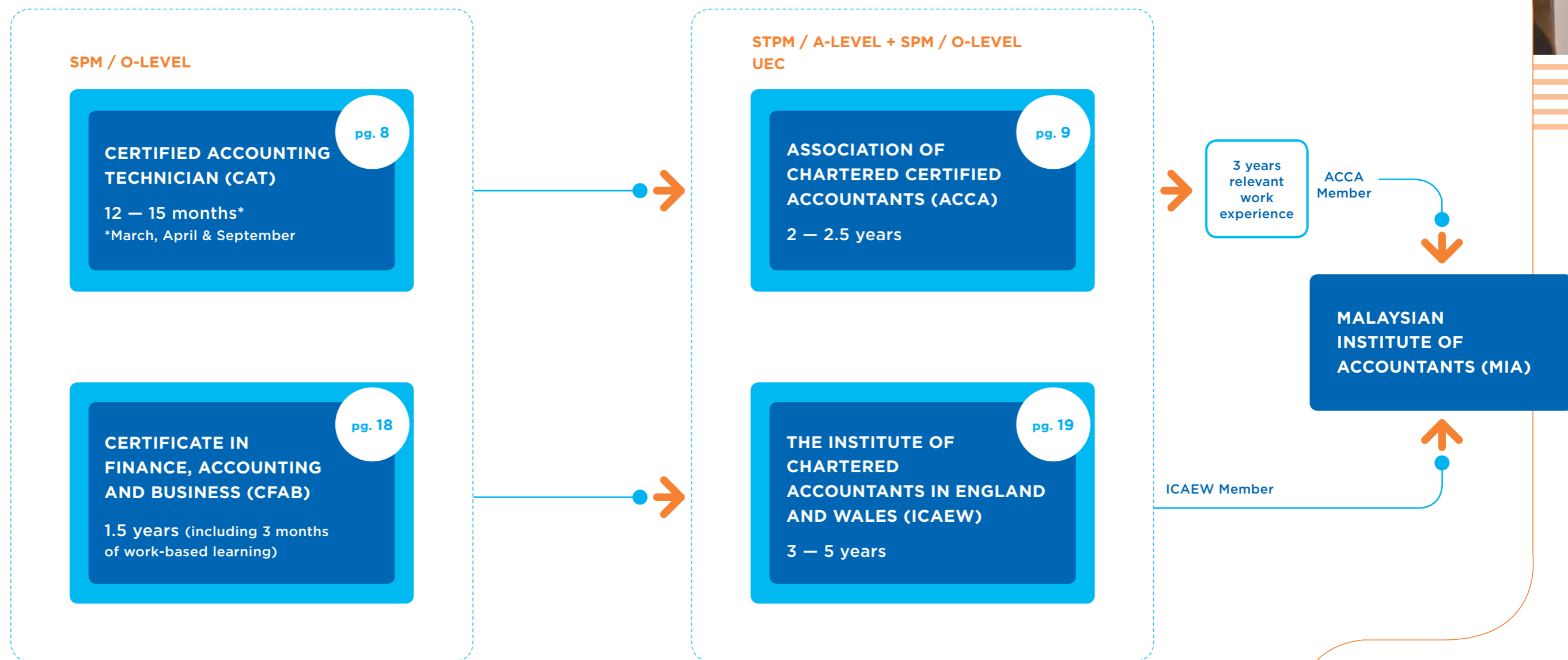

## CERTIFIED ACCOUNTING TECHNICIAN

The Certified Accounting Technician (CAT) is a vocational qualification designed by ACCA that will allow you to support the work of professional accountants. The final-level examinations are equivalent in standard to the first year of a university degree programme. Consequently, CAT graduates are allowed to move directly to Fundamentals Level (Skills Module).

The knowledge, skills and practical experience you have gained while studying the CAT qualification can exempt you from certain papers and count towards the practical experience requirement of the ACCA Qualification.

There are nine examinations to the CAT, which are split into four levels. Each level is designed to test the knowledge, skills and understanding needed to work in accounting support roles. As well as completing your examination, you will have to gain a minimum of one year relevant experience while undergoing your financial training to achieve the Technician qualification.

When you have fulfilled the criteria for Certified Accounting Technician status, ACCA will confer on you the title of Certified Accounting Technician and you will be able to use the letters 'CAT' after your name.

The CAT qualification could be your stepping stone to the ACCA Qualification and membership of the global body for professional accountants.

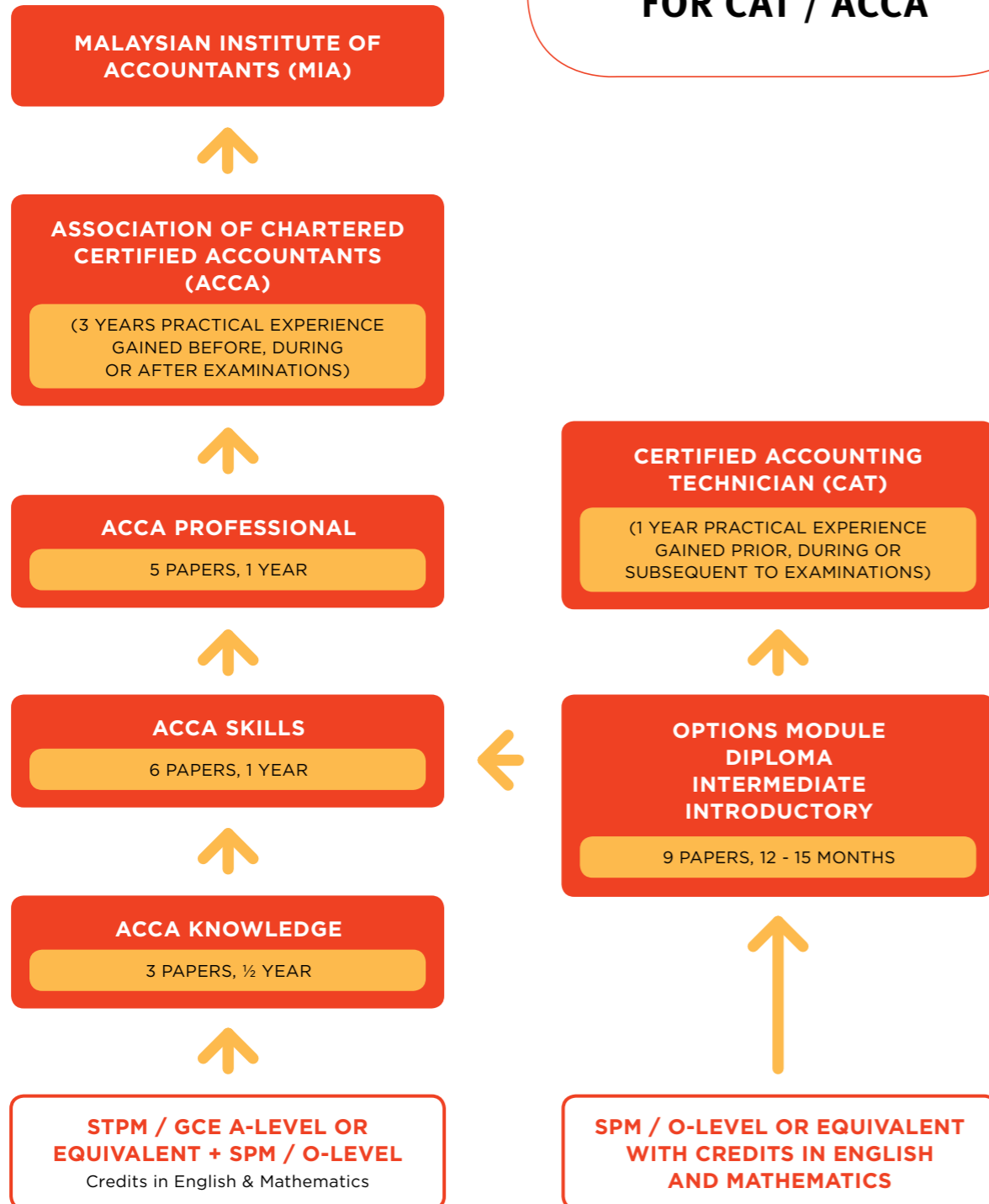

Parents' Day is held once every semester. On this day, parents are able to discuss with lecturers the progress of the students. A report on attendance and grades of internal exams will be available to enhance the discussion between lecturers and parents. Graduates with one year of relevant and supervised practical experience are required to submit their Practical Experience Requirement which may be pre, during or post examination/studies to ACCA. Upon approval, CAT graduates may add the prestigious designatory initials 'CAT' to their names.

### PROGRESSION TO ACCA

CAT graduates attempting to pursue the ACCA qualification are granted exemption from the Knowledge Module (3 papers) and thus may progress directly to the Skills Module (6 papers).

## STRUCTURED TEACHING AND LEARNING APPROACHES

Class attendance is mandatory for all lectures and tutorials. Exam Driven / Exam Focus classes for each paper are compulsory. Our lecturers provide and discuss past exam questions and techniques during these sessions. In addition, each paper consists of 2 internal exams. These internal exams are indicators of students' progress in their studies.

### Time Frame for Completion of Studies

Following ACCA's structure, students study Fundamental level have no limit years of study. Whereas, students commence study Professional Level are given up to a maximum of 7 years to complete all five modules.

Applicable to Pre-University programmes offered at Sunway College such as the Australian Matriculation (AUSMAT), Canadian International Matriculation Programme (CIMP), Monash University Foundation Year (MUFY) and Sunway Foundation in Arts (FIA). All international students are required to sit for an English Placement Test (EPT). A minimum score of 70% must be attained in order to be accepted into the programme.

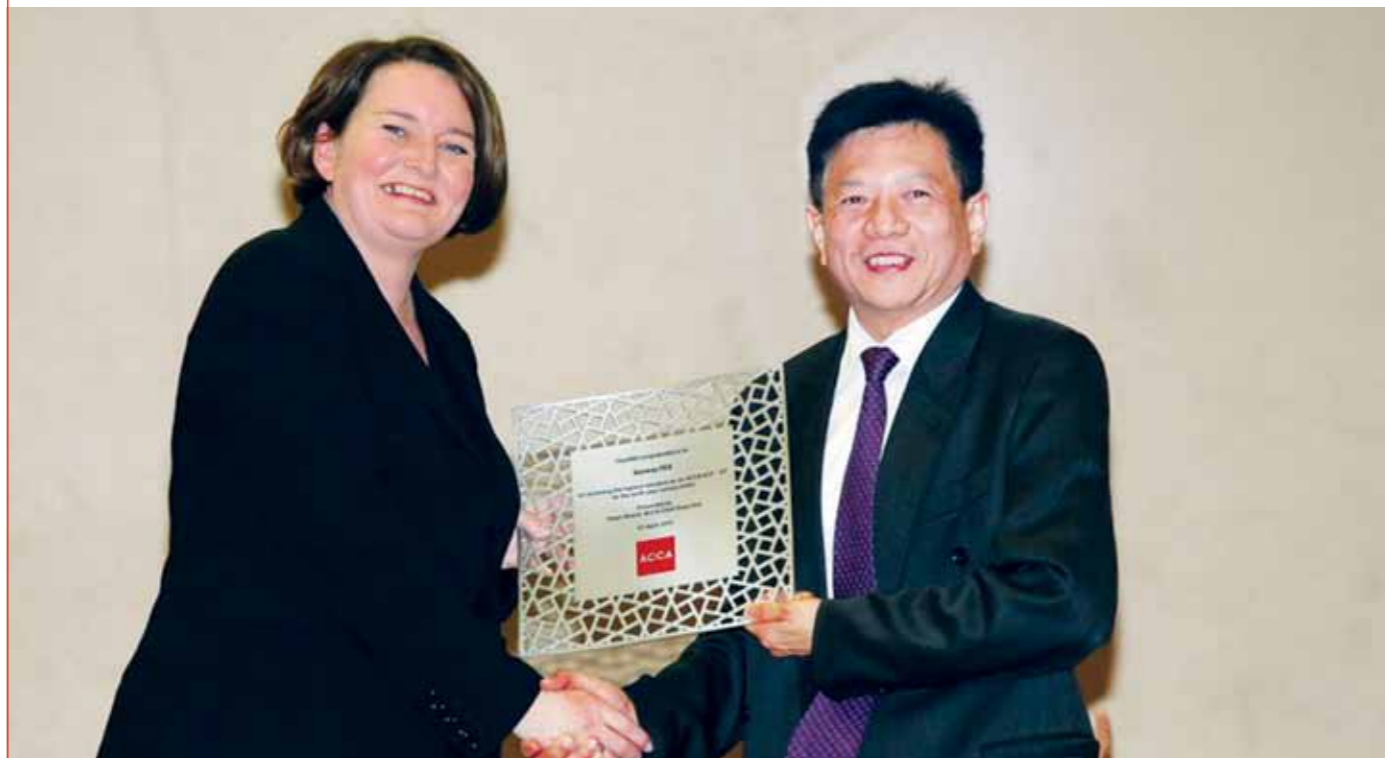

- UEC (15 points and below in best 5 subjects (including A's in English and Mathematics, minimum of B's in the remaining 3 subjects)
- Any foundations approved by MQA (average mark of 80% and above)

For pathway iv, v, vi, vii, x, credit in SPM Mathematics and English is required.

#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS\*

English language proficiency may be demonstrated by any of the following:

- Evidence that English is the language of instruction in secondary or tertiary studies completed; or
- Other English language proficiency requirements such as:
  - IELTS (academic) minimum 6.5 and at least 6.0 for each individual band
  - TOEFL (paper-based) minimum 600 and TWE (Test of Written English) 6

### The Canopy Walk

This elevated, secure walkway in Bandar Sunway connects Sunway College, Sunway University and Monash University Malaysia to Sunway Pyramid shopping mall. This walkway is a 10–20 minutes' walk from the various campuses to the mall, and entrance is secured with auxiliary police keeping a watchful eye. The Canopy Walk is open daily from 7am to 12 midnight (except on public holidays) and monitored by closed-circuit television cameras.

### Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)

The BRT runs on a dedicated elevated road, which connects to several train stations. Students can enjoy shortened travelling time as the purpose-built road avoids traffic congestion. Providing greater convenience, students can disembark directly from the BRT stations located within Sunway City.
