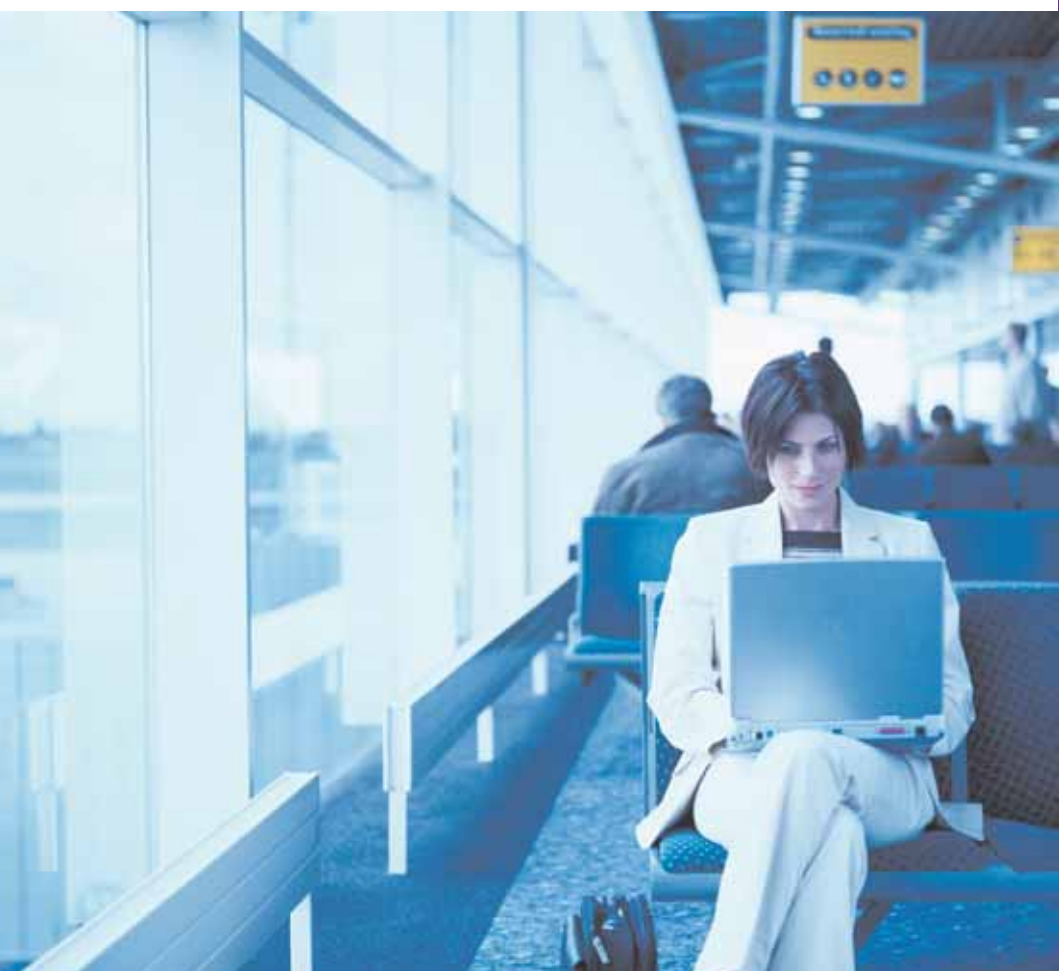

General entry - Requirements:

- Bachelor degree
- Minimum age - 27 years
- Minimum of 3 years work experience.
- Mature entry possible for those without Bachelor degree (at least 6 years of managerial experience).

At the Malaysia Centre @ Sunway University College

- Students attend intensive workshops led by the UK faculty four times during the first and second years and twice in the final half year (about 200-250 hours for the whole course).
- Extra local tutorial sessions are in place, providing a forum of discussions, developing greater understanding of the subjects and relevant topics.
- In addition to the MBS online resources, Malaysian students have access to Tun Hussein Onn Library facilities which include a collection of 130,000 books and 15,000 electronic journals.
