

ACCA Foundation in Accountancy (ACCA FIA) Launch Bursary

RM1,000 per student up to a maximum of 100 recipients who newly enrol for the 2021 intakes

Terms and Conditions

1. The ACCA FIA Launch Bursary, hereinafter referred to as the Bursary takes the form of reduction in tuition fee, which is payable on a per semester basis; it is not a cash award. In the event where the Bursary awarded is less than the tuition fee, the recipient is responsible for the outstanding fee amount. The schedule of general fees must be paid as and when required, in accordance with normal college policy fees and deposits.
2. Recipients of the Bursary will not be eligible for any other scholarship or bursary awarded by Sunway College Johor Bahru (including the Tan Sri Jeffrey Cheah Entrance Scholarship). However, the Bursary may be combined with any discounts and rebates up to the maximum value of full tuition fee per semester only. Any waiver amount in excess cannot be brought forward to the following semester.
3. The tuition fee waiver will be implemented from the 1st semester of the programme and disbursed as RM300 in semester 1, RM300 in semester 2 and RM400 in semester 3 respectively for the approved duration of study as specified by Sunway College Johor Bahru.
4. The quantum of Bursary awarded is based on the standard module plan per semester specified in the fee schedule. In the event this is not possible or for exemption cases, the quantum awarded will be pro-rated according to the actual number of subjects taken for the semester.
5. In the event that the recipient applies for transfer of programme or change of campus, the Bursary entitlement will cease. For withdrawals, suspension or termination by Sunway College Johor Bahru at any point of time, before the completion of the programme, this Bursary shall be automatically terminated.
6. Should such withdrawal, termination or suspension happen, Sunway College Johor Bahru reserves the right to ask for refund on the portion of the Bursary that has already been disbursed to the recipient thus far.
7. The Bursary shall no longer be applicable in the event of withdrawal and subsequent re-enrolment into the same programme at a later intake.
8. The Bursary does not cover general fees, examination fees, re-sit or re-enrolment and accommodation fees which must be paid by all recipients, where applicable.
9. Sunway College Johor Bahru reserves the right to review the Bursary awarded on a semester basis. In exceptional cases, bursaries may be withdrawn at any time in the event of gross misconduct or failure to meet the academic expectations of the programme.
10. The Bursary will cease upon completion of the approved study period specified by Sunway College Johor Bahru, which is 3 consecutive semesters.
11. Recipients of the Bursary are bound by Clause 3 of the Sunway College Johor Bahru Rules and Regulations pertaining to Fees and Deposits.
12. The terms and conditions herein are to be read in conjunction with the General Terms and Conditions for scholarships and bursaries governing all tuition fee waivers awarded by Sunway College Johor Bahru.
13. In the event of dispute on the eligibility for the Bursary, the decision made by the Scholarship Committee of Sunway College Johor Bahru is final.
