
Team Supernova Triumphs at ACI YLS

In 2004, the Sunway Education brand made its way south and Sunway College Johor Bahru opened its doors with a mission to educate young minds, primarily from within the state of Johor. This year, the college celebrates a remarkable milestone, aptly themed 'Two Decades of Excellence - Building Dreams, Shaping Futures.'

Our journey began in late 2004 from a temporary city campus at JOTIC while construction of the purpose-built campus was on-going. With a clear vision for the future, the move to our current campus in Taman Mount Austin took place in 2005 and have never looked back! From the early days, Sunway College Johor Bahru has grown by leaps and bounds, not just in student population but in every way imaginable.

- From a single building block in 2005 to the current 3-block facility including the on-campus residence.
- From offering 1 external qualification and 1 home-grown diploma programme to 3 international pre-university qualifications, 12 home-grown programmes and the only Australian twinning business degree in Johor.
- From our first ACCA-CAT Malaysia prize award in 2005 to 240 academic awards achieved by our students to-date.

Our journey of growth is dotted with significant milestones: being one of the first private colleges in Johor Bahru with a purpose-built campus, expanding our oncampus accommodation facilities with the Sunway College Residence (hostel) and the addition of a new academic block to cater to ever-growing student body. importantly, the Covid-19 pandemic which brought the entire world to a standstill posed unprecedented challenge. together with a common determination to not allow the restrictions imposed to affect the progress of students' learning, our academic team met the challenges head-on, rising above all constraints to deliver classes and conduct assessments remotely in addition to a massive out-of-the box Lab at Home initiative by the Pre-university programmes.

Celebrating our 20 years of presence in Johor, called for a different approach. Embracing our theme, the management and staff decided to bring the celebrations to the heart of the community with а massive 7-district education roadshow! With the endorsement and support of the Johor State Education Department (JPNJ) and in collaboration with Eduplay, our roadshow spanned several Sundays, taking us to districts of Pontian, Kluang and Batu Pahat while three days of on-campus roadshows, welcomed school teachers and students from Johor Bahru, Pasir Gudang, Kulai and Kota Tinggi districts.





This incredible outreach effort engaged over 3,500 students and 400 school counsellors over six weeks! Each academic department showcased their best, ensuring hands-on discovery and experiential learning opportunities for all attendees. It was a celebration of learning, growth and community spirit.


