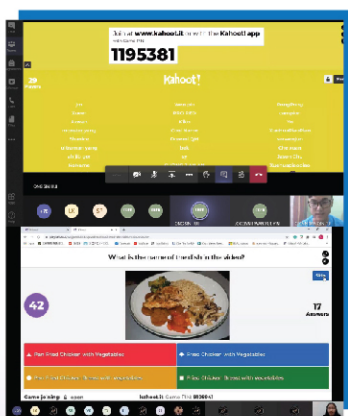
## VU Students Rise to the Challenge!

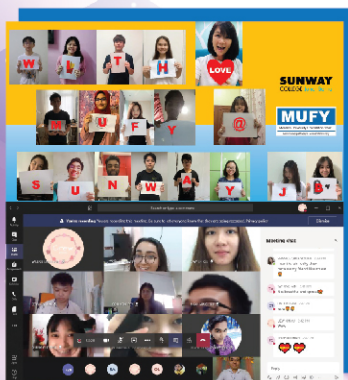
## E-Commerce Presentation by SG Shop

# MCO and the New Normal

The Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent implementation of the nationwide Movement Control Order (MCO) by the government took Malaysia by storm. The early days of the MCO had gripped the nation and crippled communities, affecting our daily lives as we know it. Staying home and not being able to go about our day to day business was a big challenge for many. Gradually, we learned to cope with the situation and changed routines became a part of daily living with 'social distancing', 'stay home and stay safe' becoming regular phrases used in place of 'hello' and 'see you soon' in conversations.

Despite the extended MCO, we were fortunate to be able to commence two student intakes even though orientation and lessons could not be conducted 'face-to-face' as planned. Our new students braved the unfamiliar and together with their lecturers, adapted to virtual teaching and learning and embraced the challenge of doing things differently.

Since July 2020, selected students were permitted to return to campus for in-person classes while plans are underway to facilitate a gradual return of all students in stages. A Covid-19 Response Team (CoRT) was formed to prepare the campus and put in place a set of preventive measures based on the Standard Operating Procedures specified by the authorities. These included procedures for entry and exit, temperature screening, contact tracing, safe distancing and the availability of hand sanitisers at frequent touch points. The mandatory requirement of wearing a face mask while on-campus is also a very important part of the preventive plan and is strictly enforced. The CoRT takes its responsibilities very seriously and team members move throughout the campus, regularly checking that all staff and students adhere to the guidelines.

The new normal is here to stay and we hope that everyone accepts, adapts to and adopts these changes as necessary. It may take us a while to adjust to this new way of life, but as long as everyone does his or her part, we can keep the virus at bay and prevent another wave.

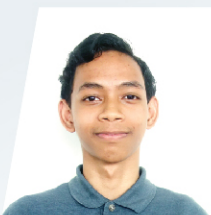

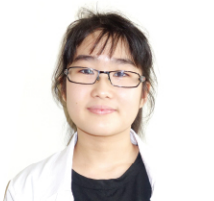

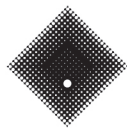
