SUNWAY COLLEGE residence



Sunway College Johor Bahru recently launched its on-campus accommodation, Sunway College Residence (SCR). The occasion was graced by members of the Board of Directors, Mr Lee Weng Keng, CEO of the Education and Healthcare Division of Sunway Group, Ms Elizabeth Lee, Senior Executive Director of Sunway University and Sunway Education Group, Mrs Hor Poh Choo, Principal and Chief Executive of Sunway

College Johor Bahru, Mr Ng Kok Cheng, Mr Char Hon Loong and Mr Char Hon Wah, Directors of Sunway College Johor Bahru.

For the launching ceremony, helium balloons in blue and white were released following the opening address by the Principal, Mrs Hor Poh Choo.

"Creating a 'home away from home' living environment, the 4-storey hostel, which is located within the campus is built based on the concept of promoting social interaction among students in a learning environment." said Mrs Hor.

The hostel was built to cope with the rising demand for accommodation due to the College's increasing student population. The hostel is a 2-block structure which houses a total of 68 units in several configurations which can accommodate 4 to 8 residents per unit. All units are fully furnished and fitted with air-conditioners and instant water heaters. Other amenities such as a 24-hour study room, prayer rooms, recreation and multi-purpose rooms are located on the ground floor. The building is fully air-conditioned and self-service launderette and beverage vending machines are available for the convenience of the residents. In her opening address, Mrs Hor also mentioned that the number of residents had doubled since the hostel first opened its doors in July 2011.

Besides the 24-hour presence of the Sunway Auxiliary Police and security personnel, an effective network of surveillance cameras (CCTV) are also installed within the hostel as residents' safety is of utmost importance. Amenities such as clinics, banks and food outlets are easily and conveniently available in the vicinity and within walking distance from the hostel.

College staff and residents of the hostel were treated to a sumptuous buffet lunch at the end of the ceremony.


GRADUATION CEREMONY
