COVID-19 ADVISORY 51: UPDATES ON QUARANTINE PERIOD & NEW ENTRY PROCESS

Dear Students, Parents & Staff of the Sunway Education Group Community,

1. I hope everyone is doing well and safe.
2. The Ministry of Health (MOH) had recently [announced updates](#) regarding the SOPs (quarantine duration, testing requirement etc.) for those who are COVID-19 Positive and Close Contacts. Allow me to briefly summarise the updates below which will be applicable across SEG:
 - a. For **COVID-19 Positive Cases**:
 - i. Quarantine period is **seven (7) days** for those who are **fully vaccinated and asymptomatic** or **ten (10) days** for those who are **unvaccinated / not fully vaccinated / symptomatic**.
 - ii. Health screening will be conducted by Health Authorities before release. For symptomatic cases / those undergoing treatment, release is subject to clearance from the Health Authorities. You will be allowed back to campus once your MySejahtera status is affixed with the 'Completion' stamp or if you have a duly authorised release letter from the authorities (as applicable).
 - b. For **Close Contacts**:
 - i. Quarantine period is **five (5) days** for those who have **received their COVID-19 vaccine booster dose** or **seven (7) days** for those who **are unvaccinated / have incomplete vaccination / fully vaccinated (but not yet received their COVID-19 vaccine booster dose)**.
 - ii. For Close Contacts **exhibiting symptoms**: You are required to take an RTK-Antigen COVID-19 test, whether self-administered or at the nearest health facility as soon as any symptoms develop. Please remember to update your test result within your MySejahtera application.
 - iii. For Close Contacts **not exhibiting symptoms**: You are only required to take an RTK-Antigen test **on the final day of your quarantine**, i.e. day 5 or 7 (as applicable), and this must be done at a government or private health facility.
 - iv. You will be allowed to return to campus provided your RTK-Antigen test is negative on the final day of your quarantine **and** your MySejahtera status is affixed with the 'Completion' stamp or has reverted to low risk profile.

QUARANTINE PERIOD FOR COVID-19 PATIENTS AND CLOSE CONTACT TO POSITIVE COVID-19 CASES ACCORDING TO COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS.



Note:
Effective 16 January 2022 and it applies to those who are currently isolating and in quarantine.

POSITIVE CASE

	Fully vaccinated and no symptoms	Partially/ not vaccinated/ symptomatic
Quarantine period	7 days	10 days

- Health assessment will be done before release can be granted.

CLOSE CONTACT

	Fully vaccinated with booster dose	Fully vaccinated/ incomplete/ no vaccination
Quarantine period	5 days	7 days
Symptomatic	Self-test RTK-Ag OR to health facilities	Self-test RTK-Ag OR to health facilities
No symptoms	RTK-Ag day 5 with supervision by health officials	RTK-Ag day 7 with supervision by health officials
Release	Day 5 if RTK-Ag is negative	Day 7 if RTK-Ag is negative

- Throughout the quarantine period, 5 or 7 days, if symptomatic, please perform self test RTK-Ag or go directly to the health facility if symptoms worsen.
- Throughout the quarantine period, 5 or 7 days, if not experiencing any symptoms, only do RTK-Ag in public or private health facilities on the last day of quarantine for the purpose of releasing.

MALAYSIA ADMISSION PROCEDURES FOR TRAVELLERS WHO HAVE BEEN INFECTED WITH COVID-19

- Travellers must have completed their COVID-19 vaccination with proof of vaccination status.
- Evidence to show that you were infected with COVID-19 within 11 days to 60 days before departure to Malaysia, through printed or digital laboratory test results.
- Travellers with a history of hospitalisation due to COVID-19 are required to submit a "Fit to Travel" letter from the hospital.
- For those who were not hospitalised, they will need to undergo a **professional RTK-Ag test 2 days** before departure. Only travel if the test result is negative.
 - Travellers are required to undergo a supervised RTK-Ag test upon arrival.
 - Travellers who are fully vaccinated and have been infected with COVID-19, within 11 to 60 days before departure are EXEMPTED from mandatory quarantine.
 - Unvaccinated and not fully vaccinated travellers are required to undergo quarantine at the quarantine center for 7 days.

New Entry Procedure: e-Tap

4. We will be implementing **e-Tap**, a **new entry procedure** for all individuals entering our Sunway University and Sunway College Kuala Lumpur campuses beginning **7 February 2022**. System testing is underway (so please bear with us).
5. e-Tap details as follows:

e-TAP: NEW ENTRY PROCEDURE

1 Scan your MySejahtera



2 Show MySejahtera status to Security

3 Check Temperature

4 e-Tap your Staff/ Student ID Card

(If you do not have your Student/ Staff ID, you must manually fill in the entry log-book provided)



6. Visitors / Vendors / Contractors will also be required to scan and show their MySejahtera at the entry points as well as inform the on-duty security personnel the purpose of their visit.
7. As it is a Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) requirement that student and staff attendance on campus is logged and reported to them daily, **please remember to bring along your ID Card at all times when accessing campus**, and **to duly perform e-Tap at the entry points**.
8. With the implementation of this new entry procedure, e-Declare will be phased out at SunU and SCKL campuses. However, the **e-Trace system** (for entry into offices / classrooms / labs / cafeteria etc) will still be continued as part of the SOPs (this is to facilitate contact tracing etc).
9. We seek everyone's cooperation to adhere to this new procedure and all SOPs. Let us ensure that our campus remains a safe space for all.

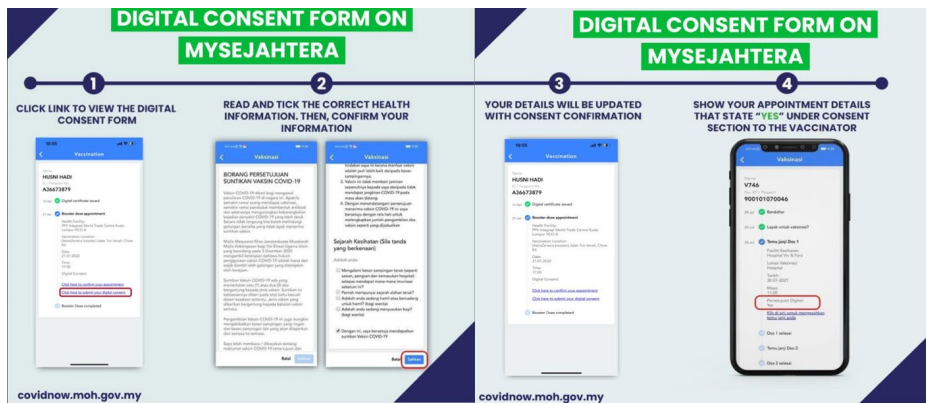
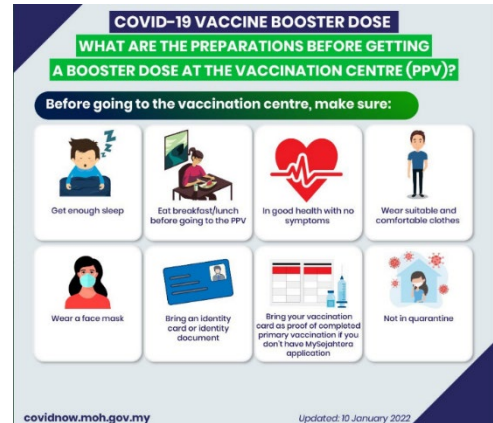

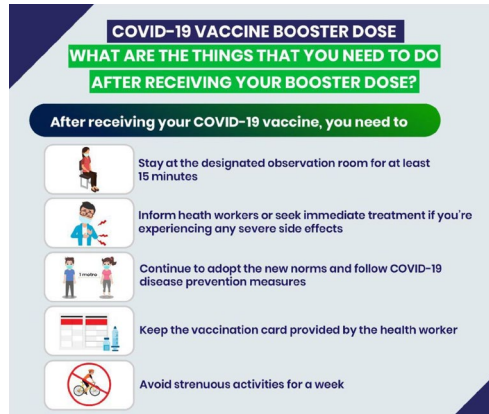
