UPDATE: STUDENT EVENTS & SPORTS ACTIVITIES

- 4. The SEG COVID-19 Committee has also resolved that all student events and sports activities will be allowed to take place, subject to the following observances:
 - a. Only those who are fully vaccinated will be allowed to participate. Students with valid reasons for not being fully vaccinated may participate on a case-to-case basis.
 - b. All organisers and attendees must register via MySejahtera (and be of Low Risk or Casual Contact No Symptoms status) and scan the eTrace when entering venues.
 - c. Event organisers must record the attendance of all attendees.
 - d. Venue capacity is subject to physical distancing of at least 1 meter.
 - e. External guests are allowed to attend/ be present, subject to strict adherence to campus SOPs.
 - f. All participants/ guests/ attendees are strongly encouraged to take a COVID-19 RTK-Antigen Self-Test before entering the campus in order to attend events or participate in sporting activities.
 - g. For indoor events, the venues must have proper ventilation.

5. In addition to the above, you would have noticed that additional seating capacity (subject to 1-meter distancing) to accommodate the increasing number of people on campus has been provided. Quiet study spaces are also available for students.
