
The Government will allow only <u>Fully Vaccinated</u> Individuals (Students, Staff, Visitors & Vendors) to enter campus



A person is considered fully vaccinated when:

- a. Two-dose vaccine (including Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Sinovac, Moderna and Sinopharm): 14 days after second dose
- b. Single-dose vaccine (such as Johnson & Johnson and CanSino):28-days after vaccination
- For international students who have received your vaccinations abroad, please contact the International Office on how to get your vaccination certificate verified by the Malaysian authorities

Your MySejahtera will also indicate once you are fully vaccinated:

Under MOHE's **VACC2Campus Programme**, all HEI students can walk-in to get vaccinated.

- a. For Existing Students, bring along your student ID Card.
- For New Students, bring along your Sunway College/ University Offer Letter.

For **Students below 18**, you need to be accompanied by a **Parent/ Guardian** to sign the vaccination Consent Form. Please contact Student
LIFE if you need assistance or MOH (details in the next slide)

Before Returning To Campus



Local Students

- **1. Fully Vaccinated:** Please ensure you are fully vaccinated. Non-fully vaccinated individuals will not be allowed to enter campus.
- 2. Notify your Institution/School/Programme
- 3. Campus Return/ Authorisation letter: Will be issued only to eligible students.
- 4. Inter-state travel documentation:
 - To/ Within West Malaysia: the Sunway authorisation letter suffices
 - To Sarawak: Sunway authorisation letter + Police Permission
- **5. Non-returning students**: Online learning will continue to be available.
- 6. SEG Residence Students:
 - Fully vaccinated students are not required to undergo isolation but are required to undertake an RTK-Antigen self-testing kit upon check-in.
- Students awaiting to get vaccinated/ their fully vaccinated status will be
 allowed to return to the Residence, but are required to immediately isolate
 for 10-day upon arrival or take a RT-PCR/ RTK-Antigen test at an authorised
 hospital/ clinic within 3 days prior to returning or RTK-Antigen upon arrival.
 Reminder: You will not be allowed to enter campus before you are fully
 vaccinated and would have to continue learning online from your Residence.

- **7. Daily entry-exit:** Only fully vaccinated students are allowed to enter campus daily and must complete health screening (temperature check, eDeclare, etc) upon entry.
- 8. Other matters: Please contact your respective Institutions/ School/ Programme HODs/ DOPs or the SEG COVID-19 Helpline at +603 7491 3883 / 3884

International Students

- 1. Fully vaccinated international students must contact the International Office (IO) before making travel arrangements and to comply with authorities' procedures.
- 2. Please reach out to the IO team if you have any questions regarding the processes and procedures. This includes:
 - a. Visa and immigration requirements
 - b. Verification of vaccines received overseas
 - c. Travel arrangements
 - d. Pre-arrival COVID-19 test
 - e. Quarantine
 - f. Campus accommodation
 - g. Airport pick-up and transportation arrangements to campus accommodation
 - h. Campus entry and commencement of classes documentation




Student Return Flowchart: Travel To Sarawak




Student Return Flowchart: International Students

- Obtain entry approval from Malaysia Immigration Department
- Download MySejahtera application
- Make full payment (via online) for quarantine & COVID-19 testing upon arrival



COVID-19 exposure tiers

How close do you have to be to a COVID-19 positive case to undergo testing or quarantine? The following exposure tier system, adapted from MOH guidelines and advice from Sunway Medical Centre, can help shed light (and what happens if you are within the tier).



Tier 1

A <u>confirmed case of COVID-19</u> i.e. an individual with laboratory confirmation of infection with COVID-19, irrespective of clinical signs or symptoms.

What to do? Individual must also immediately notify their respective Programme Administrators / Institution/ School.

What happens? MOH protocol for quarantine activated and will contact individual. SEG Health & Safety will do contact tracing. Deep cleansing and disinfectant exercise to be carried out immediately at affected areas.

Tier 3

Individuals having sustained contact within 1 meter or less with a person in Tier 2.

Does not require home quarantine and can return to campus as there was no direct contact with a COVID-19 positive person.

Does not require medical attention unless symptoms develop. Must continue to practise good personal hygiene, wear a mask at all times, maintain social distancing and adhere to all campus SOPs.

Tier 2

You are a <u>close contact</u>: Please refer to next slide

What to do? Close contacts identified by SEG Health & Safety based on eTrace / by Institutions/ Schools will be notified following the case investigation. Or if individual knows they are a close contact, to notify SEG.

What happens? According to MOH, all tier 2 close contacts must self-quarantine and stay home/ residence for 7 days (for Fully Vaccinated) or 10 days (if not Fully Vaccinated) from the last contact date with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19. MOH will contact you provide guidance regarding the COVID-19 testing requirement. The individual will be allowed to return to campus once given the all-clear from the health authorities.

Tier 4

Individuals having sustained contact within 1 meter or less with a person in Tier 3.

There is deemed to be no identifiable risk.

Does not require self-isolation or home quarantine and can return to work.





COVID-19 Close Contact

Who is a close contact? According to the authorities, Close Contacts are individuals who have been Face-to-Face (F2F) or in physical contact with a COVID-19 positive individual in the last 10 days (or as advised by MoH). This includes:

- **Health officials who provided treatment** or **visitors** to a COVID-19 positive individual without wearing the appropriate PPE gear;
- Individuals who live in the same household with an individual positive for COVID-19;
- Working with or being Face-to-Face (F2F) in a closed space together with a distance of less than 1 meter apart, for a duration exceeding 15 mins;
- In the same vehicle for over 2 hours sitting within 2 meters of an individual positive for COVID-19; or
- Together in an enclosed room without proper ventilation for more than 2 hours continuously.

Flowchart: Student Unwell

- (1) Fully Vaccinated student arrives on campus and displays or declares in eDeclare that they have COVID-19 symptoms (temperature/bodyaches/fever/flu etc)
- Note 1: If student mistakenly fills up eDeclaration form, they are NOT ALLOWED to resubmit.
- Student must contact the Registry at +603 7491 3883 / 3884 to clarify before being allowed onto campus.
- If student needs any support, please immediately contact your Institution/ School Programme Administror (PA) contact details in subsequent slides.




